Membership:

We have different classifications: General Membership is \$125, pro-rated from January 1 of each year for new members. Our membership fees are less for Non-resident, Cruising Memberships and Associate Membership. There is a one-time initiation fee of \$50, to accompany all applications, unless the prospective member is a member in good standing transferring from another PICYA* yacht club.

Processing (applications) includes posting the prospective member's name(s) in the Club's newsletter, [The Signal](#), which is published four times a year. Given this schedule, we will present new Applications for Membership to our members through the Internet, Board Members will then vote accordingly. New Members will be asked to attend the following MBYC meeting, at which time they will be introduced to the Board and attending members.

Membership Benefits:

Belonging to MBYC entitles members to reciprocal privileges with other yacht clubs throughout the Delta and greater Bay Area. This includes guest docking, clubhouse privileges and use of facilities (though not always free). Our membership in PICYA extends this benefit to include most West Coast yacht clubs. Cruising members have enjoyed a warm welcome at clubs throughout Mexico, Central America, the Pacific Rim and at other ports of call around the world.
